#### 3 Concord Hospital Stage 2 Redevelopment

The MSC members wanted more information on how to progress the Stage 2 redevelopment of Concord Hospital. Several are interested in contributing to the Stage 2 redevelopment group when it is formed.

There are also questions about the clinical services plan, and how this should be updated to address the new redevelopment.
