Hi Hayley,

Only 5 facilities were reviewed in relation to potential capacity increases (*Balmain, Canterbury, Concord, RPAH and MH – though MH reduced slightly to meet facilitation requirements of 1:8*).

Overall placement capacity increase is the following:

Overall <b>original AM capacity</b> for the five facilities noted above was <b>195</b>	Overall <b>updated AM capacity*</b> for the five facilities noted above is <b>269</b>	<b>Variance</b> <i>+37.95% increase in available AM placements.</i>
Overall <b>original PM capacity</b> for the five facilities noted above was <b>141</b>	Overall <b>updated PM capacity*</b> for the five facilities noted above is <b>240</b>	<b>Variance</b> <i>+70.2% increase in available PM placements.</i>

Thank you to both you and Hayley, for the opportunity to work with me to review your nursing clinical placement capacity commencing from cycle 1, 2025. This is the beginning of a process to future proof our nursing workforce.

Please find attached the *updated unit profiles* for RPAH.

I will arrange a follow up meeting in early December to confirm any changes or unit additions and confirm bed numbers are correct – any changes advised at that time will apply from cycle 2, 2025.

I am unable to compare the increase in hours of available clinical capacity between cycle 1, 2024 and cycle 1, 2025 as cycle 1, 2025, is not yet 'active'. However, I can confirm the revised clinical placement capacity (in numbers) for cycle 1, 2025 and provide a comparison with cycle 1, 2024.
