

### Treasury Codes- Definitions

	<b>Category</b>	<b>Definitions</b>
<b>1</b>	<b>Medical</b>	Employees remunerated under a medical practitioner Industrial Award. Includes, interns, residents, registrars, staff specialists, clinical academic, career medical officers, Clinical Superintends
<b>2</b>	<b>Nursing</b>	Employees remunerated under a nursing Industrial Award. Includes mothercraft nurses, assistant in nursing, trainee enrolled nurses, enrolled nurses, residential care nurses, registered nurse, nurse counsellors, nursing unit managers, nurse educators, nurse practitioners, clinical nurse consultants.
<b>3</b>	<b>Corporate Services</b>	Employees providing the following services; senior management eg hospital executives includes all general managers. Other hospital executives and their personal assistants not elsewhere included and sector managers (where applicable), internal audit, public affairs/public relations, human resources/legal/workforce/industrial relations, accounts/finance/purchasing, general records, capital/assets management, computer telecommunications and information services and performance management contracts/policy
<b>4</b>	<b>Allied Health Professionals</b>	Employees remunerated as a audiologist, pharmacist, social worker, dietitian, physiotherapist, occupational therapist, med radiation scientist, clinical psychologist, psychologist, orthoptist, speech pathologist, orthotist/prosthetist, medical radiation therapist, nuclear medical technologist, radiographer and podiatrists
<b>5</b>	<b>Other Professionals, Para-professionals &amp; clinical support staff</b>	Includes employees that are not included in medical, nursing and allied health professions, who provide, plan or support the provision of patient care. For example:  drug & alcohol counsellor, sexual assault worker, social educator, health education officer, aboriginal health co-ordinator, aboriginal health education officer, interpreter, diversional therapist, surgical dresser, wardsperson, orderly, patient services assistant, residential care assistant, pharmacy assistant etc
<b>6</b>	<b>Scientific &amp; technical support staff</b>	Includes professional and technical employees who assist and provide clinical staff scientific or technical advice and services, e.g.  hospital scientist, medical technologist, dialysis technician, electronics technician, perfusionist, technical officer, dental technician, biomedical engineer, research officer/assistant, analyst/chemist, cardiac technologist, cytology scanner, heart/lung technician, sterilisation technician, environmental health officer etc.
<b>7</b>	<b>Hotel Services</b>	Includes employees who provide non-clinical services that include food services, cleaning, transport, care parking, security, linen, waste management and retail services.
<b>8</b>	<b>Maintenance &amp; Trades</b>	Includes employees who provide non-medical services that includes, trade workers, (labourers, carpenters, plumbers), boiler attendants, gardening and grounds management, contractors etc.
<b>9</b>	<b>Ambulance Staff</b>	Includes all Ambulance On-Road and Ambulance Support Staff
<b>10</b>	<b>Oral Health Practitioners &amp; Support Workers</b>	Includes all employees providing oral health services to clients, which includes dentists, dental assistants, dental hygienists, dental therapists
<b>11</b>	<b>Hospital support workers</b>	Includes employee who provide non-clinical services that support or plan the provision of clinical services at a hospital or network level such as ward clerks, IT support officers, project officers and planners.
<b>12</b>	<b>Other</b>	Employees not group elsewhere
