LIVING AWAY FROM HOME ALLOWANCE

PURPOSE

This Information Bulletin advises that the Living Away from Home Allowance in the *Operational Ambulance Officers (State) Award* has increased effective 1 July 2017.

KEY INFORMATION

As per Treasury Circular TC2017-010, Living Away from Home Allowances contained in the *Crown Employee's (Public Service Conditions of Employment) Reviewed Award 2009* have been increased effective 1 July 2017.

Accordingly, the allowances for the *Operational Ambulance Officers (State) Award* have also increased, effective 1 July 2017.

The applicable rate is determined by the location a relieving employee is required to attend, For Tier 1 locations the rate is \$128.70 and for Tier 2 locations the rate is \$118.95. Tier 1 and Tier 2 locations are detailed in Attachment 1.

Future increases to the Living Away from Home Allowances in the Operational Ambulance (State) Award will be in line with Living Away from Home Allowances in the Crown Employees (Public Service Conditions of Employment) Reviewed Award 2009 (as varied or replaced from time to time), or in line with advice from Treasury that the rates have increased.
