- The role of the Director of Planning is to develop high quality strategies, directions and plans consistent with the corporate vision, mission and agreed direction/s of Sydney Local Health District and NSW Health. It involves thought leadership, high-level strategy development and strong communication.
- Planning/strategy development is concerned with the integration of scholarly research and evidence, horizon gazing, models of care, policies and plans, quantitative and qualitative data, forecasts, and clinical, stakeholder and community views. Planning processes include staff and community consultation, strategy development processes such as scanning and scenario development and the consideration and analysis of alternative options.
- The focus of the role is to ensure health services are planned to meet the current and future health needs of the District's local, tertiary, and quaternary catchment populations.
- The Director, responsible to the SLHD Chief Executive, is ultimately responsible for developing District strategic, corporate, facility, service, capital, precinct and intersectoral plans.
- The Planning Unit includes a team of health service planners.
