Hi Teresa

The CRGH MSC dialogue is proving challenging as expected.

The MSC is meeting without executive then writing to Gen with issues and demands (last letter attached) – some are reasonable and others very much out of scope (eg cleaners and nurses)..

Winston has drafted a completely new terms of reference (not yet endorsed) which are very broad and envisages multiple subcommittees. Gen and I with Jonathan Gibson gave advice to Winston yesterday about their proposed TOR. In summary it is much broader than the model by-laws envisage, overlapping clinical council and board roles and responsibilities. We provided the LHD MSEC and RPA MSC TORs as alternate recommended approaches which Winston was not accepting of though did say that he would consider this further with their membership.

The meeting that included executive this evening and was principally Winston trying to put Gen (and to a lesser extent myself) on the spot. While Angus Ritchie was very constructive other CRGH colleagues simply sat in silence (apart from Lewis Chan who was supporting Winston) ...

We are speaking further with CRGH colleagues. Thank you for any counsel you have on managing this interesting challenge.
