Re. Results of No Confidence Vote in the Chief Executive of the Sydney Local Health District, and proposed meeting of the Concord Repatriation General Hospital Medical Staff Council members, and Nursing and Allied Health Staff at Concord Hospital with the Board of the Sydney Local Health District.

Dear Board Members,

I write to advise the Sydney Local Health District Board that the Concord Repatriation General Hospital Medical Staff Council met on Thursday 29th June 2023 to vote on a motion of no confidence in the Chief Executive of the Sydney Local Health District, Dr Teresa Anderson.

The vote of no confidence in the SLHD Chief Executive was passed with 109 votes (60%) "for" the motion and 73 votes (40%) "against" the motion.

There was a counter vote of no confidence in the Medical Staff Council Chair, myself, which was lost with 37 votes (20%) "for" the motion and 151 votes (80%) "against" the motion.

I would like to arrange a meeting, via videoconferencing, of the entire SLHD Board, excluding the Chief Executive, with the CRGH Medical Staff Council members, and the Nursing and Allied Health staff at CRGH.

The reason for the proposed meeting is to inform the SLHD Board of the reasons for the vote of no confidence in the Chief Executive of the Sydney Local Health District.

I propose that this meeting is held in the week after the school holidays have passed, at a date and time convenient for the Board, on either Monday 17 July, Tuesday 18 July or Wednesday 19 July 2023, at a start time between 9.00am and 1.00pm.

I expect the meeting will take at least two hours.
