In MLHD

- 85% of people speak English only
- 18,780 speak a language other than English (7.6%)
- 3,222 people had spoken-English language difficulties (1.3%)
- 18,353 did not state the language spoken at home (7.4%)
- Most common 3 languages spoken other than English were Italian, Punjabi and Mandarin
- Most common 3 languages spoken by people who have difficulty with English were: Mandarin, Gujarati and Kurdish
- Australian Indigenous languages were reported by 382 people, the major language was Wiradjuri (294)
- Griffith LGA has the highest percentage of the population who speak a language other than English at home
