
JARROD MARSDEN Introduction



Work experience history

May 2022—present—senior maintenance planner—Aeris Resources Tritton Operations, assist with mobile plant planning, helping with transition from SAP to Pronto, developing PM maintenance strategies, component changeout strategies, OEM BOM's etc.

September 2017—May 2022—Maintenance superintendent—Peak Gold Mine

Reporting to the Maintenance manager, responsible for all surface, ore processing, underground, and hoisting fixed plant as well as light mobile fleet maintenance activities. Also project managing structural remediation and plant replacement programs.

Reporting to the ore processing manager, responsible for all surface and ore processing maintenance activities (mechanical and electrical). Also project managed the installation of 3 x TC40 flotation tank cells, a 4 downcomer and a 10 downcomer Jameson cells—total value 8 million dollars.

Responsible for planning all electrical and mechanical maintenance activities in the ore processing department, assist with budget preparation as well as tracking of costs and monthly reporting, manage projects in the ore processing area, plan and execute all shutdown activities, develop and implement process improvement's, and manage / liaise with external contractors and suppliers.

June 2008 to April 2009—surface mechanical tradesman—CSA mine

Responsible for carrying out mechanical maintenance activities in the ore processing area, including preventative and breakdown maintenance of SAG mills, various slurry and water pumps, conveyors, concentrate filters, thickeners, floatation cells ect.

Nov 2002 to June 2009—underground fixed plant fitter—CSA mine

Responsible for preventative and breakdown maintenance of underground fixed plant including the dewatering pumping system, crushers, hoisting, winder, loading station, ventilation system, as well as underground water and compressed air piping circuit.

Responsible for the day to day maintenance and operation of the milling circuit. Including experience in grinding, floatation, filtering, tailings and backfill areas. The work team was made up of tradesman who maintained as well as operated the plant.
