Sports Medicine

As a practitioner in Jindabyne and the Snowy Mountains from 1976 to 1984, a large part of my work was within the various ski resorts of Perisher Valley, Smiggins Holes and Thredbo, culminating in my running the Thredbo Medical Centre in conjunction with my associate, in 1983 and 1984. For six years I assisted an Orthopaedic Surgeon in Canberra approximately twice a month with his work involving injuries to the knee. I have assisted a Sydney based Orthopaedic Surgeon for four years with similar work.

Extended Hours General Practice

During my time as a country practitioner I became aware of the need to provide a 24 hour and 7 day general practice facility to the public. This awareness and the experience acquired in running a large multi-centred general practice has enabled me to apply these ideas to general practice within a metropolitan setting after my return to Sydney in 1985.

During my appointment as Managing Director, the Parramatta Centre and Pacific Occupational Health and Safety were established, the latter growing to be the largest provider of occupational health services in Sydney, and possibly Australia.

Pacific Medical Centres grew to service 250,000 patients a year, involving 50 general practitioners, 100 staff as well as visiting specialists, pharmacists, radiographers, physiotherapists and optometrists.

Radiology in General Practice

As a result of my interest in x-ray services in medical centres, I represented a large group of medical centre operators before a Senate Committee of Inquiry in 1991.

As a result of that representation and my submission, the Committee recommended that the proposed Regulations be disallowed, and that the Minister for Health, Housing and Community Services be asked to repeal the Regulations, which he did.

Motor Sport Medicine

I have had a keen interest in motor sports since my university days, and have been involved both as a competitor and as an official. I have been a member of the Historic Sports Racing Car Association for many years, and have been Honorary Medical Officer at most of the Club's events. Since 1998 I have been medical officer at many other motor sports events, including motor bike racing, dirt bikes and go-kart racing and I enjoy this particular aspect of my medical career. I currently hold a C3 CAMS license and race an historic sports car in category S(a).

Aged Care

I have always had a large aged care practice, and in my semi-retirement, established Batemans Aged Care in 2023 and treat only residents in RACF, generally about 100 in number.
